

# CATALONIA'S COMMITMENT TO THE 2030 AGENDA



2015

- The Catalan Government creates an [inter-ministerial working group](#) on SDGs.

2016

- The Government pledges to develop a [National Plan for the implementation of the 2030 Agenda](#) and to elaborate an integrated system of targets and indicators.
- The Advisory Council for Sustainable Development of Catalonia (CADS) launches “[The 2030 Agenda: Transform Catalonia, Improve the World](#)”, with contributions from experts and members of the civil society. This report to the Government offers key elements for identifying SDGs in Catalonia.

2017

- In February an [inter-ministerial commission](#) including all 13 ministries is created to lead the Plan in progress, ensure internal consistency and monitor its compliance with SDGs. A technical committee with representatives of all ministries starts working on the Plan. Both bodies are assisted by the CADS.
- The technical committee works with 17 groups coordinated by ministries with key powers relating to SDGs. Due to the crosscutting of SDGs, no ministry plays a leading role and so each one can bring each other into the discussion in the same capacity, thus [breaking down possible silos](#).
- A first draft of the 2030 National Plan is [delivered to the Government on 7<sup>th</sup> July](#). The Plan integrates SDGs from all across public policies, plans, programs and regulations: it maps the UN 2030 Agenda targets into [clear and tangible commitments](#).
- The Plan contains [more than 750 commitments both within Catalonia and into the larger world](#) with Catalonia as an agent. The Plan sets deadlines for the accomplishment of those commitments, specifies ministries in charge and includes a set of indicators for assessment.

2018

- The 750 commitments are presently under review by the Government. Further crosscutting issues will be subsequently mainstreamed: gender, intergenerational solidarity and socioeconomic equality. A [policy coherence](#) test will be implemented.
- SDGs are at the core of the new [2030 Vision for Development Cooperation](#) and the 2019-2022 Master Plan for Development Cooperation.

2019

- A [participatory process](#) will be developed in the first semester of the year seeking a two-fold goal: promoting social engagement with the Agenda and enriching the commitments.
- [Ratification of the Plan](#) (expected for June 2019)
