







Regions Race to Resilience

Regions4 is a global network of subnational governments mobilizing ambitious leadership of regions for impactful action on Climate, Biodiversity & Sustainable Development, to build a resilient future for all.

At the Paris Climate COP21 in 2015, Regions4 launched **RegionsAdapt**, the first global initiative that inspires and supports subnational governments in developing ambitious adaptation strategies, implementing concrete actions and transparently reporting on their progress. With more than 70 signatory members impacting over 300 million citizens, RegionsAdapt is mobilizing ambition on adaptation worldwide.

Since 2021, RegionsAdapt is an official partner of the Race to Resilience, focusing on engaging subnational governments (states, regions and provinces) in the global effort of raising ambition in adaptation to tackle climate change.

The Race to Resilience is a global campaign led by the Marrakech Partnership for Global Climate Action High-Level Climate Champions – launched in January 2021 to catalyse a step change in global ambition for climate resilience, putting people and nature first in pursuit of a resilient world where we don't just survive climate shocks and stresses, but thrive in spite of them.

The Race to Resilience aims to catalyse action by non-state actors to build the resilience of 4 billion people from vulnerable groups and communities to climate risks by 2030.

Regions Adapt leads the Regions Race to Resilience which offers States and Regions the unique opportunity to showcase action, drive ambition and learn from peers around the world.

WHAT DO STATES AND REGIONS COMMIT TO WHEN JOINING THE REGIONS RACE TO RESILIENCE?

States and Regions who want to demonstrate their leadership on adapting to climate change and join the Regions Race to Resilience are invited to commit to the following pledges:

1. ASSESS

climate change impacts through vulnerability risk assessments that include all vulnerable communities

3. ACT

to implement concrete actions on adaptation in key identified priority areas

2. PLAN

prioritize and adopt an ambitious adaptation plan and/or programme (mainstreaming adaptation into other sectoral policies), including the most vulnerable, with interim targets and long-term goals

4. REPORT

annually on their progress through the <u>CDP States</u> and <u>Regions reporting platform</u> to inform and improve policies and actions, and track their commitments to the Race to Resilience
