Regions4 has launched a partnership with the UN Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) to make a leap forward in the global engagement and impact of regions on sustainable development. The partnership will capitalize on the best practices developed by leading Regions4 Members and on the experience gathered by UN-Habitat through the SDG Cities Global Initiative. Other partners will contribute with their technical know-how and networks of relations to refine and disseminate the results.

The joint project will run in three phases:

- Creation of a framework for regional government capacity on SDG implementation
- Activation of technical assistance to help regions apply this framework
- Support for regions to secure investments for key enabling actions
